In addition, all national holidays, festivals and anniversaries of great personalities will be observed and celebrated in the school. The children are allowed to go home on the same day and have to return on the last day of the vacations and breaks. For instance, students will go home for summer vacation on 01.05.2025 after 02:30pm only.

### **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

#### **REPORTING AND LEAVING THE SCHOOL**

- | Parents are requested to drop their wards between 1 p.m. to 5 p.m. on the day of the reporting after Vacation/Special leaves.
  
- | A fine of Rs. 100/- per day will be charged if a student comes late after the Vacation or break.
  
- | If a student comes on the day of re-opening after 5:00 p.m., he/she will still be charged a fine of Rs. 100/-.
  
- | If a student is unable to report on the day of reporting, parents should inform the School in advance either by mail or phone.

#### **ABSENCE FROM SCHOOL**

- | If a student remains absent for 15 days without any intimation, the student's name will be automatically struck off from the School rolls without any notice.
  
- | In such incidents parents have to apply for fresh admission.

## **CASH, VALUABLES, ELECTRONIC GADGETS & BANNED ITEMS :**

- Students are not allowed to keep/use drugs, tobacco, pan masala, cigarettes, bidis, cash, Cell Phone, I Pad, camera, radio, walkman, tape recorder, wrist watch, gold/silver/diamond ornaments or any other valuable articles with them in school. Such items, if found with the students, shall be confiscated.
- If any student is directly or indirectly found in possession or using of any electronic gadget, drugs, tobacco, pan masala, cigarettes, bidis, cash, Cell Phone, I Pad, camera, radio, walkman, tape recorder, wrist watch, gold/silver/diamond ornaments in school, it will be considered a serious offence and a fine of Rs 5,000/- will be imposed on first instance.
- The school reserves the right to rusticate the child on second instance.

### **Remarks for parents:**

If the parents wish, they may deposit cash & camera in the school office under receipt. The student may take camera or cash while going on picnics/excursions/outings/tours. After returning back, the student should deposit these items back in the office.

## **UNIFORM :**

- School uniform is a standard set of clothes which is worn by the students and they must respect it.
- Student shall be allowed to enter or exit the School campus only in proper School uniform.
- Without proper school uniform the student may not be allowed to enter the school premises.
- School uniform shall not be altered. School uniform will be confiscated if any change/alteration found in it and disciplinary action will be taken.
- Students are not allowed to wear fashionable, short, sleeveless, obnoxious clothes in the School.
- Fancy jewellery, nail polish, long nails, make up, and fancy belt, tattoo, applying henna gold/silver / diamond rings and ornaments are not permitted.
- Students are not allowed to report to school with religious threads tied on their wrists, kada bracelet, ring, amulet, friendship belt, tattoos, pierced ear/ear rings etc.
- The dress wearing style should be decent and not indecent or stylish.
- The socks should be of normal length and should not be worn turned down.
- Students are not allowed to colour / spike / gel their hair, No eccentric/fashionable hair style will be allowed.
- Girls' pinafores should cover their knees.
- Girls are not allowed to have untied/loose hair.
- Hair is to be tied in two plaits with white ribbons.
- Boys' hair must be cut as per the School style.
- The school will not entertain any excuse pertaining to long hair or stylish haircuts.
- Grown-up boys should be clean shaven with no stylish beard.

**TUCK :**

- As sufficient nutritious food is provided by the school, parents need not to provide snacks/packed foods/eatables to their children.
- This disturbs their fitness and may lead to health problem.
- However, Juice (conc), Horlicks, Maltova, Complan, Dry fruit powder, Honey and Dry fruits & such items are permitted. Whoever directly or indirectly found managing/ordering/bringing any other food from outside shall be liable to disciplinary action.

**LANGUAGE :**

- Being an English medium School, students are required to speak only in English in the school premises. Speaking in Gujarati or any other language is strictly not allowed. If found doing so, a fine of ₹100 (One Hundred Rupees) will be imposed.

**SPORTS AND GAMES:**

- All sports and games are compulsory for all the students.
- If any student is sick, doctor's advice not to play or the parents do not wish that their child should not take part in any games/sports, then parents have to submit written application and take permission from the principal accordingly.
- If a student is good at sports and has to participate in any games or competitions outside the school, he/she has to compulsorily participate.
- Any expenditure made for this shall be charged from the parents.
- No further permission shall be sought from the parents in this regards.

**SAFETY :**

- Safety of our students is our prime concern.
- The School authority, staff, coaches / escorts do take extreme care for security & wellbeing of students during School/functions/ tour/sports/transportation, etc.
- In case of any untoward unavoidable incident beyond the limitations of staff/escorts/School authorities, the staff/escorts/School authorities shall not be held responsible.
- Parents are admitting their children to the School at their own risk and costs.

**SCHOOL PROPERTY:**

- In cases of serious willful damage caused to the property of the School by a student, the parent/guardian of the student would be liable for costs of damage to the School property.
- In such incidents the Management's decision will be final and binding.

### **EDUCATIONAL TOUR:**

- Educational Tours, adventure courses, picnic, camps and trekking are an integral part of education and a *sine qua non* for all round development of the children.
- Educational Tours, Adventure Camps, Trekking will be arranged for classes III to XI.
- In addition to the above tours, short picnics and study trips will be organized.
- All such activities are compulsory for all students, except tours for more than 2 days are not compulsory.

### **COMMUNICATION:**

- Parents are prohibited to contact the children directly.
- They can convey important messages through School office.
- Similarly the students shall talk to their Parents through School office only.
- Students shall be permitted to talk to their parents on mobile phone on the days decided by the management from time to time.
- Students will write letters to their parents every fortnightly.

### **MEDITATION :**

- The main notion behind establishing MKGM School by His Holiness Param Sant Thakar Singhji Maharaj is to introduce self- realization in the children through meditation along with imparting modern education.
- Twice a day meditation is compulsory for all students.

### **TEXT BOOKS :**

- As most of the students are coming from remote villages and town and as many students are staying in the hostel, books are not being available easily and timely, the School provides books to the students at market rate.
- However, notebooks are easily available everywhere so parents have to provide necessary notebooks to their children.

### **PARENTS & VISITORS NOT ALLOWED ON SUNDAYS / HOLIDAYS:**

- Parents and visitors are not entertained on Sundays & holidays as the office remains closed on these days.
- Hence, parents and visitors are requested NOT to come on Sundays/holidays, unless specifically requested by the school to come on a particular Sunday or a holiday, as in the case of school closing or reopening after holidays and on Annual Day or Annual Sports Day functions or PTM.

### **MEDICAL INSPECTION:**

- Medical inspection of all students is conducted on the arrival at the school after holidays, leaves and vacations.
- Please don't send your child to school if he / she is not well, especially, when he/ she is suffering from any infectious disease.
- Please send an application for leave along with Medical Certificate of illness in such cases.

### **MOVIES :**

- Weekly movies screened shall only be religious, social, patriotic, educational, etc.
- The movie selection shall be entirely at the school's discretion.

### **WITHDRAWAL :**

- Parents desirous of withdrawing their ward from school from the next academic session have to give notice of withdrawal by 31st January.
- In case the notice is received after 31st January, the caution money (refundable) will be forfeited.
- The annual fees is payable in two installments. However, in case of withdrawal of the student in mid- session, full year fees has to be paid.

### **MEETING WITH THE PRINCIPAL & STAFF :**

- Parents may meet the Principal in between 03:30 pm. to 05:30 pm. from Monday to Saturday.
- To avoid inconvenience, please make prior appointment.

### **LEAVING SCHOOL CAMPUS WITHOUT PARENTS :**

- No student is allowed to leave school campus without parents.
- Due to any reason parents are unable to pick their ward, they have to give written application stating clearly with whom the child shall be leaving the school campus.
- No student shall be allowed to leave the campus with any unauthorized person.

### **RAGGING:**

- Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited within the premises of the school.
- Any individual or group of individuals who indulge in an act or practice of ragging constitutes gross indiscipline and such individual/ groups shall be dealt with as per the rule of law.

If a student is found violating these rules, as a disciplinary action a fine of rupees 5000, unless otherwise stated, will be imposed on first instance. The school reserves the right to rusticate the child on second instance.
